Japan-UAE Medical Cooperation to be Enhanced

- 1. Fujita Health University of Japan and UAE University will sign a cooperation agreement on September 3, 2014. Through this agreement, the two universities will promote exchange in areas of medical education and research. They will exchange students, researchers and staff, conduct collaborative research projects, organize symposia, and exchange research data and materials.
- 2. Through the visit of H.E. Shinzo Abe, Prime Minister of Japan to UAE in May last year and the visit of H.H. Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi to Japan in February this year, the two Governments renewed their determination to strengthen the comprehensive partnership between the two countries. The medical cooperation is one of the priority areas to be covered by the partnership between the two countries. The agreement to be concluded between Fujita Health University and UAE University is a part of the efforts by the two countries in this respect.
- 3. The agreement is scheduled to be signed by Dr. Kiyotaka Hoshinaga, President of Fujita Health University and H.E. Prof. Mohammed Al Baili, Provost of UAE University on September 3 at UAE University.
